



USGA RULES AND THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY.

- Your position on the golf course is immediately behind the group in front of you, not in front of the group behind you.
- Red stakes or red painted lines define lateral water hazards.
- Out-of-bounds is defined by white stakes, white painted lines, surrounding paved streets and property fences.
- Ground under repair is defined by enclosed white painted lines and newly sodded areas.
- Relief may be taken for an embedded ball through the green. App. I, 4a.
- Cart paths and the stones related to paths are deemed immovable obstructions. Relief from interference of stance or swing, nearest point of relief, no penalty.
- Stones may be removed from bunkers prior to play. App. I, 5b.
- Please repair ball marks and fill sand divots.
- Proper attire is required at all times.
- Turf irrigation is non-potable water. Avoid contact.
